2025 Round-1 Grant Cycle

The Operation RoundUp Board of Trustees has awarded \$47,000 in grants to the following organizations:

Dearborn County | \$9,500

- Pregnancy Care of Southeast Indiana \$2,500 to purchase a triple screen laptop
- St John Lutheran School Nutrition Program \$2,000 to expand their summer meal program
- The Archaeological Research Institute \$2,500 to transform green space to include garden beds, signage, and a gathering area for educational purposes
- **Greendale Police Department** 2,500 for a new projector for meeting room, including mount and ceiling speakers

Jefferson County | \$5,600

- **Jefferson County United Way** \$2,500 to update registration cards for imagination library with new branding.
