AIR SOURCE / DUAL FUEL HEAT PUMP REBATE

Rebate for a new constructed heat pump or replacing another electric resistance heat, gas, A/C or heat pump. Rebated equipment must be installed in primary residence.

MINIMUM EFFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS:

Stick-Built or Modular Housing SEER ≥ 16, EER ≥ 10 Mobile/Manufactured Housing SEER ≥ 14, EER ≥ 10

Mobile/manufactured homes are defined as factory assembled, transportable, designed for transportation on own chassis, can be placed on temporary or permanent foundation and intended for year-round occupancy. Modular homes must be residential single family homes.

HEAT PUMP REPLACING GAS, EXISTING A/C OR HEAT PUMP OR NEW CONSTRUCTION INSTALLATION (Up to \$750)

Dual/Variable/Multi-Speed Compressor ONLY. Units that do not qualify include: window air conditioners and "thru-the wall" heat pumps (hotel-type machines). Single speed compressors for mobile/manufactured homes only qualify.

HEAT PUMP REPLACING 100% ELECTRIC RESISTANCE HEAT (Up to \$1500)

Must be replacing primary heat source for entire home.

- SINGLE SPEED COMPRESSOR
- DUAL/VARIABLE/MULTI-SPEED COMPRESSOR

The following DO NOT qualify for 100% electric resistance replacement: Heat pump with electric resistance, space heaters, gas furnace, wood stove, wood pellet stove, A/C, back-up heat, generators.

Limit of two rebates per member household per life of the rebated equipment. Rebates for HVAC equipment are available for whole home installations only unless otherwise stated. To receive a rebate, all homeowners must provide AHRI (Air conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) validation for all SEER and EER ratings that can be obtained from the installing heating and cooling dealer. No rebate will be awarded based on HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional material of dealer, manufacturer or any other source than AHRI. A certificate of AHRI-certified performance must be submitted.

All homeowners must complete a rebate application form and provide proof of purchase to receive any 2023 rebate. Application must be received by Southeastern Indiana REMC by December 15, 2023 and within 90 days of the rebated equipment's installation date in order to qualify for the 2023 Rebate Program.

The cooperative reserves the right to approve, deny or select the appropriate rebate. The co-op also reserves the right to inspect and verify installation of equipment receiving a rebate.

Should the applicant receive power from any source other than the electric cooperative, including generation owned by the customer, before the end of the equipment's deemed useful life, the applicant agrees to refund the full amount of the rebate to the distribution cooperative.

Applicant understands that Hoosier Energy may use the usage information provided for program evaluation and analysis. If signing in a capacity other than an individual capacity, the individual signing hereby represents and warrants that s/he is duly authorized to execute and deliver this application on behalf of the applicant.
11. Southeastern Indiana REMC reserves the right to approve, deny or select the appropriate rebate amount.
12. Applications must be received within 90 days of the rebated equipment's installation date in order to qualify for the 2023 rebate program.
13. Applications received by Southeastern Indiana REMC between December 16, 2022 and December 15, 2023 are eligible for the 2023 Rebate Program. Applications received after December 15, 2023 will be processed under the 2024 Rebate Program requirements.
