Virtual Meeting

Due to the COVID-19 meeting restrictions, the annual meeting will be held virtually on March 30 at 6 p.m. EDT.

Director Election

Electing directors is one of the most important activities that takes place during the annual meeting each year. This year the membership will elect directors from districts 2, 3, and 6.

The candidates from district 2 are Bradley Bentle, Jeffrey Bittner, and William Kirk. The candidate from district 3 is David Smith, and the candidate from district 6 is Mike Thieman.

We have published "Meet the Candidate" videos for each of the director candidates to give everyone an opportunity to learn a little more about them and why they are running for a seat on the SEIREMC board of directors. These videos can be viewed on our website and social media channels.

Ballot packets were mailed to every member on March 1. The packet included a ballot, voting instructions, candidate information, and a return envelope.

If you choose to complete a paper ballot, please be sure to mail it in enough time to arrive by the voting deadline on March 26.

If you choose to vote electronically, you have two options. You can vote online or through the SmartHub app. Voting closes at 11:59 p.m. EDT on March 26, so please make sure you submit your vote before the cut-off.

The results of the director election will be announced live during the virtual annual meeting.

REMC Scholarships

Headquarters Building Project

In January, we announced the approval of the new headquarters building project.

The existing headquarters building was built in the 1940's and has outlived its useful life.

The construction of a new pole barn is complete and demolition began on the REMC Training Center, mechanics garage, and several other

old storage buildings on the property on March 1.

Bruns Gutzwiller Inc. has been selected for the project and we expect to break ground for the new headquarters building in May.

We will continue to provide updates throughout the project timeline.
