SOUTHEASTERN INDIANA REMC OPERATION ROUNDUP PROGRAM AWARDS OVER \$62,000 TO COMMUNITY PROJECTS

The 9 member Operation Roundup Board of Trustees met January 28, 2021 and determined that these 36 grant applications met all the requirements. The grant money is made possible through the generosity of the REMC membership by "rounding up" their monthly electric bill to the nearest dollar amount.
