SEEKING DIRECTOR CANDIDATES

Southeastern Indiana REMC is seeking qualified candidates to run for director positions in the 2022 Director Election. Potential candidates must reside in one of the following districts.

District 4

Center, Hogan and Washington townships in Dearborn County; Randolph township in Ohio County; and Posey and York townships in Switzerland County.

District 5

Cass, Pike and Union townships in Ohio County; Caesar Creek township in Dearborn County; and Brown, Shelby, and Otter Creek townships in Ripley County.

District 9

Jackson, Johnson, Franklin, Center, Delaware and Washington townships in Ripley County.

Candidates are elected by their fellow members at the annual meeting through a majority vote. The 2022 annual meeting takes place on *Saturday, March 26*, at South Ripley High School. Directors are required to maintain membership with the cooperative, holding permanent residence in one of the nine districts within the service territory. They serve three-year terms; thus districts rotate on a three-year basis.

The nine-member board of directors acts on behalf of the membership, ruling in the

members' best interest while governing the cooperative. The REMC board of directors is the legal body that both the members and the regulatory agencies hold accountable for the actions of the cooperative. Their responsibilities include overseeing long-term financial planning and corporate objectives, strategic planning, governing rates and rules of service, operating philosophy and policy, operating budget and the general manager evaluation. Directors maintain a vast knowledge of the electric industry, participate in regular training and certification and attend civic, community and industry events throughout the year.

Members may run by nomination or by petition. All candidates are required to complete a Candidate Statement of Interest form, which is available on our website. Petition forms, also available on our website, must be signed by at least 30 members and be returned to the REMC office by *January 26*.

The hybrid-election will be conducted with several voting options in 2022, including mail-in, online, and onsite voting. Prior to the cooperative's annual meeting, all members will be mailed a paper ballot and instructions for optional online voting. These options will be available beginning February 22 and ending March 22. Onsite voting will take place during registration at the cooperative's annual meeting on March 26.

22 kW Generator Price Increase Coming

ORDER NOW TO LOCK IN THE CURRENT PRICE

Like many things over the past couple of years, the cost of Generac generators and supplies have increased, and we need to adjust our price accordingly. Starting January 1, 2022, we will implement a price increase for a 22-kW total home back-up generator.

The price for a 22-kW total home back-up generator (including installation and maintenance) will change from \$5,900 to \$6,900. This increase affects all orders placed after December 31, 2021.

We will continue to offer a one-year financing option to ease the financial burden of the purchase.
